SMA MISSION APPEAL: In our parish next weekend Feb 28th and Mar 1st.

The Society of African Missions (SMA) was founded in France in 1856 and when it was established in Ireland in 1878 it was the first exclusively missionary congregation to send out missionaries from Ireland. The main mission of the SMA is in Africa where the Society works in 17 countries. Today there are just over 900 members and 270 students preparing to be missionaries. The SMA asks for prayers and financial help to support its missionary work.
